

A Receipt for the Cure of the Bite of a mad Dog

Take the false tongue of a Colt and Grated fine and Under jaw bone of a dog burnt and the teeth taken out Clean, and made fine to a powder, the filings of a bout Six good Coppers, nine or ten Roots of the bloodroot - Dried and made to a powder, the bark of the Root Sassafras. A Proportion Equal to the Bloodroot made to a powder -

The above ingredients must be well mixed together for a dose, take half a tea Spoonful at a ^{ny} time in the day fasting and immediately after filing a bout half a good Copper to a grown person, so in Proportion to Children the.

Second dose the same as the above in 24 hours -

After giving the first, the Patient must -

Refrain from all kinds of fats or oily meats butters Milk Spices of Every kind kind for at least 4 days and let his drink be teas or water with a tost in N. B. a proportion only of the Powdered jawbone Equal to the bloodroot is to be annexed let the medicine be taken in molasses or honey Sweetmeats or water is esteemed the best -

The whole dose may be taken at one time if the Patient is of a Strong Constitution

A Receipt of Croupes Cure for

The filings of the half Copper taken immediately after must be taken by the patient Separate the filings of the half Copper to only be in the first dose
